



Eucharistic Congress Activities for Children & Youth

- * Non-separating children's activities (children must be accompanied by a parent): a nursery and nursing moms space, age 0-3; outdoor games (like cornhole, parachute play, hackysack), all ages; outdoor picnic concert with Armstrong Brass Quintet, all ages; service projects (Kids Against Hunger food pack, emergency kits for the homeless, cards to the homebound), age 8+. And children are welcome with their families all over the Congress, at talks, music sets, confession, adoration, Mass, procession, and the exhibitor/vendor area.
- * Separating children's activities (children—age "potty trained" to 12--can be dropped off by a parent): a morning session and afternoon session run by the Servidora sisters. Each session will include an age appropriate talk on the Eucharist and activities and/or discussion (kids will be placed into rooms by age group). Parents are welcome to attend with a child but it is not necessary that parents attend. There will be a limit on how many children can attend, but we are talking in the 300 range for each session.
- * NET Ministries is coming! Teens will be able to enjoy spending time in a lounge area with coffee and drinks served by St. James Coffee (located in a Rochester). They'll also find adults there who are ready to talk about the faith, engage in discussions about what they are hearing from the keynote speakers, and explore how they can live their faith in everyday life at home, in school, with friends, and in their extra-curricular activities. We also plan to have live music eat times throughout the day. Of course teens can take part in the service projects and in the lawn games as well.
