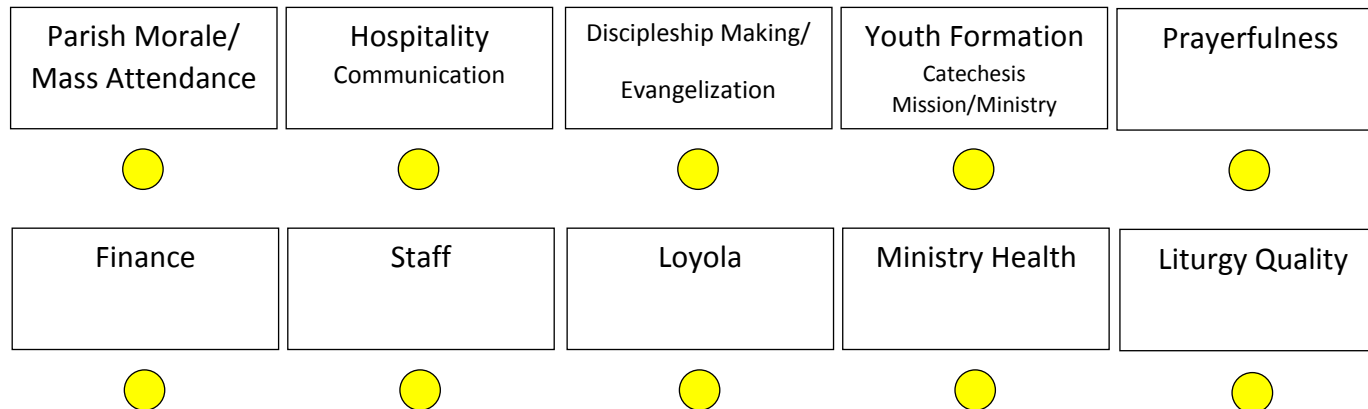
- The Pastoral Leadership Team met with the Journey to Justice Committee to explain the structure of unifying St. John's ministries under St. John's mission Statement (We bring people to Christ by living like Christ through prayer, service and learning) and the 3 categories of Prayer, Service, and Learning. Many times there is overlap, conflict and duplication among the ministries because none of the ministries know what the other is doing. Two ministries may be donating money to the same charity and not know it.

The Journey to Justice Committee is being asked to be the communication tool among the ministries in the Service category, the parish and the Pastoral Leadership Team. Their duties primarily are to educate, collaborate and help set the budget for the Service ministries. They would meet 5 times a year.

The Sunday Experience Team would be the canopy committee over the Prayer ministries and the Faith Formation Advisory Board would be the canopy committee over the Learning ministries.

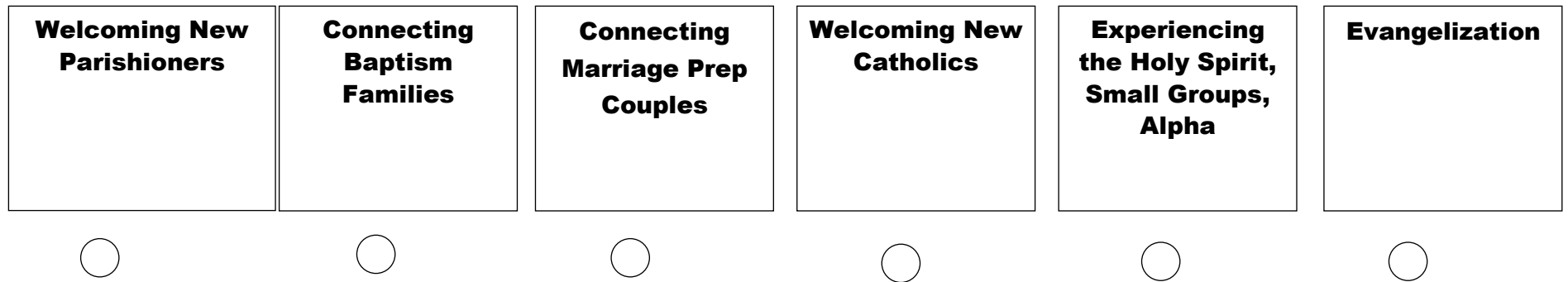
- Other Business: Monica has found a point person to represent St. John's on the Connection ministry (a community effort to provide shelter for the homeless in Mankato).
